## FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR —

**What A Feast !** — Last Saturday about 100 parish members had a true international feast celebrating the **Feast of Pentecost** with foods from countries like the Republic of the Congo, Poland, the Dominican Republic, Italy, Mexico and many more. We all met at least one person we had never met before, and tried a food we had never eaten before -- a few visitors even stayed. Thank you to all who were able to bring a food, and to the Parish Life Committee, who coordinated the event. The Spirit of God was indeed present!

**Perk's Picks** — Father Richard Rohr is a priest of the Order of Saint Francis (a Franciscan) and a very prominent author in the area of Christian Spirituality. He is the founder and director of a reflection, spiritual renewal center in Arizona. I just finished reading (now re-reading) his latest, and I think most insightful book — Falling Upward: The Two Halves of Spiritual Life. It is a very practical, ordinary spirituality into which Fr. Rohr invites the reader, and he offers many “profound nuggets of wisdom” to reflect upon, which may well challenge the typical spiritual presuppositions we are living out of. As July unfolds, I hope to offer a three-session reading group based upon this book -- perhaps if there is enough interest, one in the morning and one in the evening. The cost of the book will be about \$13.00. If you wish to order a copy, there will be a sign-up sheet in the Commons, or call June at the Parish Office.

**A Constant Calling** — In the documents of Vatican Council II and in Pope John Paul II's exhortation, “Pastores Dabo Vobis,” all members of the Church are called to fuller holiness and greater understanding. When speaking to priests they declare: “Continuing formation and ongoing growth are absolutely necessary for priests. ‘Rekindling’ one's vocation is essential.” To that end priests are expected to spend two weeks every year in continuing education, as well as regular private reading and an annual retreat. You as the People of God also should expect that of us priests. I try to be faithful to that call and expectation.

Therefore from June 24 - July 1, I will participate in a few seminars at a ministry renewal program sponsored by Notre Dame and Loyola Universities. From July 1-5 I will spend the holiday with my Mother and family.

Father Bob French is graciously willing to preside at the weekend eucharists while I am away; and Carol Dufresne, our Pastoral Associate, will assist parishioners in their needs.

The Christian Canon of the Scriptures, the New Testament, excluded many of the Church's traditional stories about its origins. This Apocrypha Literature included well-known tales. These early Christian legends have had a profound influence on art, literature and theology from the second century through the Middle Ages and even to modern times. They have influenced the visual representations of Christ in mosaics, paintings and sculpture. Msgr. Lane will combine text and art. There will be opportunities for questions, and handouts will be available.
